Educational Presentation

- Adult Protective Services (APS) Marne Schroeder, Director of Community Treatment and Amanda Flatter, Manager of APS
 - Information provided on DHS 55 and services provided by APS which include outreach, counseling, referral and coordinating services, case management, guardianship referrals, adult at risk, elder at risk, etc. A total of 1098 APS clients were served in 2023
 - Priorities for 2024 include being fully staffed, increase knowledge of mental health and 51 system, collaboration across networks, and increase education distribution to community partners

Year-End Financial Update – J. Hake

- J. Hake provided a review of the draft December financials and preliminary year end financials. There has been a significant positive change in the Behavioral Health Services net income due primarily to the change in practice and strategies that have been implemented.
- Chair Gibbs complimented staff on the diligent work in turning the financial picture of the organization around.
- Today we received notification from DHS that we can fully open the Medically Monitored Treatment (MMT) program and are in process of preparing for a full census of 16 and reaching out to partners.

Approval of November 28 2023 and December 13, 2023 Executive Committee Meeting Minutes

• **Motion**/second, Stowe/Leonhard, to approve the November 28, 2023 and December 13, 2023 Executive Committee meeting minutes. Motion carried.

Financial Update – J. Hake

- The preliminary December and year-to-date financials were reviewed. Net income in December was \$776,000. For the second month in a row Behavioral Health Services ended with a positive net income. Overall, we had a good month.
- Year-to-date preliminary financials ended with a net income of \$1.9 million. Behavioral health had a significant improvement from 2022 of about \$1.5 million. Mount View had a very good year of \$2.6 million mostly due to Medicaid rate increases. Pine Crest also ended with \$450,000 in the black which is contributed mostly to the Medicaid rate increase. Staff were commended for the great work in turning the financials around to a more stable position.

Year End Review of Senior Leadership Accomplishments for 2023

• The 2023 Senior Leadership Accomplishments were reviewed by the Senior Leadership Team.

Approval of Pine Crest Contract Amendment

- The proposed Pine Crest Nursing Home Management Agreement amendment was reviewed. The amendment is being requested to allow Lincoln County the ability to negotiate the potential sale of the nursing home to:
 - allow for the flexibility to end the nursing home management agreement sooner than the currently required 180-day notice;
 - clarify that equipment and personal property on Pine Crest premises are the property of Lincoln County, and to transfer employees to a potential buyer.
- R. Krueger suggested an additional amendment (see attached) be included in the event Lincoln County or NCHC would like to end the Nursing Home Management Agreement:
 - upon mutual termination, even in absence of a sale, NCHC will transfer employees and equipment to Lincoln County.
- **Motion**/second, Krueger/Leonhard, to approve the amended version of the proposed 1st Amendment to the Nursing Home Management Agreement. Motion carried. The amended 1st Amendment will now be presented to Lincoln County for approval.

Sick Leave Benefits for Pine Crest and Lincoln Industries Employees Policy

- With the Nursing Home Management Agreement amendment approved by this Committee, the recommendation is being made to revise the Sick Leave Benefits for Employees of Pine Crest Nursing Home and Lincoln Industries contingent upon approval by the Lincoln County Board of the amended 1st Amendment to the Nursing Home Management Agreement.
- The revisions to the policies were reviewed.
- **Motion**/second, Leonhard/Stowe, to adopt the policies with the amendments as provided today contingent upon Lincoln County Board approving the amended 1st Amendment to the Nursing Home Management Agreement as adopted by this body. Motion carried.

Fund Balance Policy and Cash Management Policy

- Jason Hake reviewed the changes to the Fund Balance Policy. Handout of page 59 of our audit document was provided as added clarification to the revisions.

• Lincoln County Board met on Mon, Feb. 19 and approved the amendment to the nursing home management agreement. They also approved the sale of Pine Crest effective June 30, 2024. A team is being created to help with the transition to the new owners. The new owners met with staff yesterday.

- Per the Tri-County Agreement, the Executive Committee sets the wage scale each year. The Committee is being asked to approve a 3% increase in the wages cale for 2024.
- NCHC is in the process of conducting a wage scale study. When the new wage scale study is completed, the company will present a report to the Executive Committee for their approval. Committee agreed the wage study is important to maintain competitive wage scales.

Approval of September 21, 2023 Nursing Home Operations Committee Minutes

• Motion/second, Bialecki/Hartwig, to approve the September 21, 2023 Nursing Home Operations Committee meeting minutes. Motion carried.

Executive Director Report – G. Olsen

- Update Regarding Pine Crest Nursing Home
 - We have been informed that there is a potential buyer of Pine Crest Nursing Home. The current Management Agreement requires a 180-day notification to terminate the agreement. Therefore, in preparation of a potential sale, NCHC Corporation Counsel and Lincoln County Corporation Counsel have worked together on an amendment to the nursing home agreement giving flexibility to the required notice to terminate the agreement. The agreement also states that equipment will stay with the nursing home as Lincoln County property as these purchases were made with Lincoln County funds.
 - An amendment to the sick leave policy is also provided and is contingent on the approval of the amendment to the nursing home agreement. The policy amendment states that employees will stay employed with Pine Crest, and North Central Health Care (NCHC) will not actively recruit/hire employees for six months following sale. Also, employees under age 55 will need to stay employed with the new owner for six months to receive their sick leave payout. Employees over 55 will be paid their sick leave balance and will not be required to wait six months.
 - NCHC will continue to run operations during this process. Lincoln County's obligation is to compensate NCHC for losses and any obligation of compensated absences between sick leave and depreciation.

Financial Report – J. Hake

- Financial reports for both nursing homes are unaudited therefore there could be changes following our annual audit.
- Mount View Care Center (MVCC) 2023 year to date net income was \$2.6 million. Kristin Woller and the MVCC team have managed expenses well. We have seen a large increase in Medicaid rates last year and have had an average census of 115. Chair Gibbs expressed sincere thanks to Ms. Woller and management for an outstanding job.
- Pine Crest Nursing Home (PCNH) 2023 year to date net income was \$451,000. Ryan Hanson and PCNH team have also done a great job managing expenses. Again, the increase in Medicaid rates positively impacted the financials.
