Human Services Team Collaboration



I was happy to be invited to write for this week's leadership article, and to be able to share some great conversations that occurred this week with our Core Values at play:

On May 14th and 15th, NCHC leadership met with leaders and staff from our partner counties' social services departments at the Lake View Conference Center on the Wausau Campus, Social

Services Directors Christa Jensen, Jessi Rumsey, and John Zenkovich shared their thoughts on the improved collaboration between our agencies. Together, we serve the most vulnerable populations through programs mandated by the State of Wisconsin. These span from Economic Support, Child Support, Child Welfare, Youth Justice, and our NCHC Community Programs including our Crisis Center, Crisis Stabilization Facilities, Behavioral Health Hospitals, Outpatient Services, and Community Treatment.

Our Director of Outpatient Services, DeAnna Dertz, and Wendy Peterson, Director of Acute

Care Services provided information on substance use disorder treatment. Highlighted information included Outpatient therapy and services, Lakeside Recovery, our Sober Living program, and outreach by our peer specialist and recovery coach. Additional information was provided on how to access our services and the scope of each program we operate was explained. Department of Social Services' staff asked great questions and made valuable suggestions for future ideas for group programming for youth.

We acknowledged that we are part of a continuous improvement system and how important open communication is. We know that we will not always be able to say "yes" to each other's specific requests, however, we are all committed to articulating what we can do rather than just saying "no."

This is the first in a series of meetings that will occur every few months as we network together and build our collaboration.




